Who qualifies?

Residents of Lake Havasu City who have/are

- Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COP D)
- Congestive Heart Failure (CH F)
- Pneumonia
- Acute myocardial infarct ion
- Coronary bypass surgery
- Stroke
- Fall admissions/fall risks
- Care manager referrals

What is the paramedic program for?

- Assess your breathing and take your vitals
- Help you with your discharge instructions
- Review medications and answer questions
- Assess needs for community programs
- Assist with making your follow-up physician appointments
- Identify safety and fall risks within the home

Where is the assessment done?

- The Lake Havasu City Fire Department will visit your home and complete this assessment in the comfort of your home.

When will this happen?

- You will receive a call within 24-72 hours upon registration for the program from the Lake Havasu City Fire Department administration.
