

# Our Community Impact

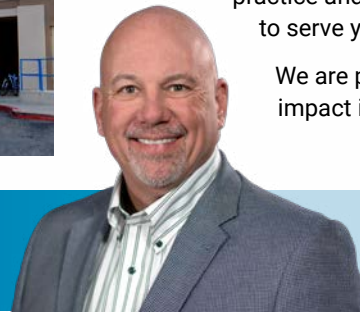

### Invested more than \$8.9 million in capital improvements

By continually investing in our facilities, we're helping to ensure that we continue to meet our community's healthcare needs. This year's investments included opening a new outpatient physical therapy and cardiac rehabilitation gym, new fluoroscopy equipment and storage room, Stryker surgical towers and an upgraded MRI machine and suite.
